Tasked with maintaining the original integrity of the building while realizing a contemporary redesign, the contractor and designer went with a simple look to bring the concept back to the 1950s post-modern era when the building was constructed.

Single-variety plantings, such as *Sansevieria zeylanicas* in a bed of mixed rock, exemplify the minimalist look of the time. Low liner plants open the mall up and contribute to the linear look.

Down a central walkway, cordatum, bromeliads and mixed rock fill groupings of raised planters, positioned in a corner configuration. In the center, low rows of *Sansevieria* 'Moonshine' form the focal point.

Jutting in toward the circular fountain in another bed, plantings of ZZs top dressed with sheet moss stand out against dividers of light-colored rock. For a soothing effect, black polished river rock lowers the output of the fountain.

Dracaena marginata 'Colorama' and sheet moss divide a circular bed into pie-shaped sections.

In another area, three beds of ZZs are accented by a fourth bed of seasonal-color bromeliads.
